2. COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS

(1) Required Subjects

Through a placement test and interview (implement in April and September), student will be placed into one of the five levels of Basic Japanese. In order to complete the course, the student is required to take 10 credits in Spring semester and 10 credits in Fall semester, altogether 20 credits in one year.

(2) Elective Subjects

The student is required to take more than 5 credits each semester and is required to consult with class instructors before completing the registration. Besides the subjects of the Course in Japanese Studies for Overseas Students, student can also take subjects of the faculty to complete the credits for Elective Subjects.

(3) Subjects of the faculty

You can get the credits if you pass (over 60) the subjects of the faculty at Kyoto University of Foreign Studies. The detail information on taking these subjects will be given in the Orientation.

(4) Study Tour

Besides (1) & (2), study tour is also part of the course. Failure to participate will be considered as absent from all classes for the day(s).
