

Periodic Health Checks for Students

Periodic health checkups for students are conducted every year in accordance with the **School Health and Safety Act**. The purpose of these checks is to detect illnesses at an early stage and to promote the maintenance of good health, so please **be sure to take the health check every year**.

Please confirm the schedule below and be sure to attend your medical on the designated date and time.

If you are unable to attend on the designated date and time due to unavoidable reasons such as poor health, you may attend on another date and time during the health checkup period. If you wish to not participate in these medicals due to disability, gender identity, religious beliefs, etc., please consult with the Office of Medical Services in advance.

<Precautions for medical checkups>

- The obligation to wear masks on campus **has been lifted**.
- Please make sure that your body temperature is not higher than 37.5°C on the morning of your regular health checkup at home.

(If you have a fever (37.5°C or higher) or cold symptoms, you will not be allowed to attend the checkup.

- Please wear clothes that are easy to put on and take off.
- If you have corrected vision, your eyesight will be measured with glasses or contact lenses, so please do not forget to bring them with you.
- Urine analysis can be performed even if you are menstruating.
- Please keep your valuables in your own safekeeping.

<What to bring with you>

1) Student ID card, login ID and password

2) Your WEB health questionnaire

***A copy of your answers (e-mail) or a screenshot of your completed answers will be used during the medical.**

3) **Plain T-shirt** (HEATTECH, colored T-shirts are acceptable)

*Not suitable: printed, embroidered, lace or other decorated apparel, bra tops, dresses, etc.

4) **Hair band or hair clip** (if your hair hangs over the shoulders)

5) **Glasses/contact lenses** (for those with corrected vision)

Important: Completion of the WEB Health Questionnaire (required)

A WEB Health Questionnaire will be administered as part of the Student Health Examination for the 2023 academic year; those who have not completed the Web Health Questionnaire will not be able to undergo the medical or receive their health examination certificate. Please be sure to respond to the questionnaire during the following period.

How to Answer the Questionnaire:

Please access the URL above and sign in with your **Kyoto Gaidai Gmail address and password**. The survey will take approximately 5 minutes.

At the end, check the "Receive a confirmation email about my response" checkbox, and then click submit.

A copy of your responses will be sent to your Gmail address. Please do not delete the email, please save it as it will be checked on the day of the medical. You will also be able to confirm that you have already answered the questions on screen (A cat symbol means you have responded). Please save this image.



The Office of Medical Services, the Office of Counseling Services, or the Support Office for Students with Disabilities may contact you at a later date to confirm your responses.

<Periodic health checkups to be done>

*Electrocardiogram tests will be conducted only for students admitted in 2023 (including transfer students and re-admitted students). There is no electrocardiogram test for Bekka Students and Exchange Students.

*Students who receive a result of "observation at the next medical checkup" or "close examination required" in the electrocardiogram test carried out at the time of admission should consult separately with a medical institution.

<If you are unable to attend the regular medical checkup on campus>

If you are unable to have your medical checkup on campus, you can have a medical checkup at the university-designated medical institution until the end of April (the cost will be covered by the university). Details will be announced on UNIPA and on the bulletin board in the Office of Medical Services.

*Please note that if you receive a checkup at an institution other than those designated by the university, or if you receive a checkup after May 1 (Mon.), you will be responsible for the costs incurred.

<How to View the Results of your Medical Checkup>

The results can be viewed on UNIPA.

Go to UNIPA -> Student support -> Health diagnostic information inquiry.

<If the result of the medical shows "Further Checks Required">

In the event that your medical checkup result is that a detailed follow-up medical examination is required, if you have no subjective symptoms, you may need to undergo medical treatment and a follow-up examination within a month. Please book and attend a detailed medical examination at a medical institution, and be sure to submit the "Detailed Follow-up Medical Examination Report" to the Office of Medical Services.

***However, if you are currently undergoing treatment or follow-up observation at a medical institution, please submit your latest results (in writing) to the Office of Medical Services.**

***The Office of Medical Services will contact the student via UNIPA. Please be sure to confirm the content.**

1) What to bring with you at the time of the detailed follow-up medical examination:

- Health insurance card
- Result of the first medical
- The documentation requesting you to attend the detailed follow-up medical examination

***If you are scheduled to attend the detailed follow-up medical examination, please come to the Office of Medical Services to pick up the necessary documents and results.**

2) Costs

All costs related to the detailed follow-up medical examination are to be paid by the student.

3) Notes

If you do not submit the "Detailed Follow-up Medical Examination Report," we will not be able to issue a medical checkup certificate.

In such cases, you may not be able to participate in study abroad programs, CEP, etc.
