Level 1 (Caution)	Caution is required to prevent infection.	With the adoption of appropriate infection control measures, classes can be conducted both face-to-face and remotely. Off-campus activities (only in Japan) require the permission of the University/Junior College. However, activities that cannot avoid the "3Cs," including training camps and bus travel in groups, are prohibited for the time being.	For the time being, with the adoption of appropriate infection control measures, students who attend face-to-face classes can enter the campus without prior application, and other students can enter limited facilities, including the University Library, only if they make prior application.	With the adoption of appropriate infection control measures, extracurricular activities can be conducted only if permission is granted for the activities. However, activities that cannot avoid the "3Cs," including training camps and bus travel in groups, are prohibited for the time being.	With the adoption of appropriate infection control measures, the cafeteria, cafes and stalls are open with some limitations on their operations in terms of dishes served, etc.	With the adoption of infection control measures, outsiders can enter the campus only if they make prior application.	No outside parties are permitted to use campus facilities.
Level 2 (Alert)	Being on the alert is required in anticipation of a second or third wave even though a state of emergency has not been declared	Only remote classes can be conducted.	With the adoption of appropriate infection control measures, students can enter limited facilities, including the University Library, only if they make prior application.	No activities permitted	Closed	With the adoption of infection control measures, outsiders can enter the campus only if they make prior application.	No outside parties are permitted to use campus facilities.
Level 3 (High Alert)	Kyoto Prefecture has been designated as a prefecture where being on full alert is required	Only remote classes can be conducted.	No entry permitted	No activities permitted	Closed	No outsiders. But, those in charge of maintaining lifeline facilities on campus to ensure the functioning of the University/Junior College are permitted to enter campus.	No outside parties are permitted to use campus facilities.
Level 4 (State of Emergency)	The Japanese government has declared a state of emergency nationwide	Only remote classes can be conducted.	No entry permitted	No activities permitted	Closed	No outsiders. But those in charge of maintaining lifeline facilities on campus to ensure the functioning of the University/Junior College are permitted to enter campus.	No outside parties are permitted to use campus facilities.
