

Face-to-Face Classes (Additional) and Entry onto the Campus for Self-Study

From Thursday, October 1st, we started face-to-face classes for some courses, with the upper limit of students on campus per day set to 800 to 900, in order to prevent the spread of novel coronavirus infections. At present, however, many students take remote classes even though face-to-face classes are offered. In addition, the utilization rate of classrooms that face-to-face class attendees are allowed to use to take remote classes on campus is also low.

Based on this situation, face-to-face classes will be added from **Monday, November 23rd**. Prior to this, from **Monday, November 9th**, classrooms that face-to-face class attendees are allowed to use to take remote classes on campus will be opened as self-study rooms by reservation. - You are not required to go to the campus to attend face-to-face classes. Courses taught in face-to-face classes will also be taught remotely (live streaming and/or on-demand video classes).

- Date and Time of Use: Monday to Friday (excluding holidays and class cancellation dates) 9:30 to 19:30
- Classrooms for Self-Study: Classrooms for taking remote classes (See the URL below.)

- The number of students on campus per day is limited to 900, including the estimated number of students who attend face-to-face classes. Should the number of students on campus per day exceeds 900, the reservation for the relevant day will not be available.
- Apply by 23:59 on the day before the date of use.
- Be sure to always wear a mask and disinfect your hands on campus.
- Whenever you enter the campus, have your body temperature measured and your student ID card checked on the 1st floor of Building #8.
- When using a self-study room, do not disturb other students who are taking remote classes. Please note that students taking remote classes may speak during the classes.

- You do not need to apply if you are already allowed to enter the campus on the relevant day for other reasons, including attending face-to-face classes and visiting library.
