

7. Transportation Shut-downs, Storm Warnings and Special Warnings

(1) Transportation shut-downs

Classes will be cancelled if any of the following designated transportation systems are out of service for their entire route (not applicable for a partial route). In the event that the transportation service is resumed, classes and regular examinations will be handled as follows.

Classes		
	When a transportation shut-down is resolved before 6.30 am	Classes will begin as usual from the first class period.
	When a transportation shut-down is resolved between 6.30 am and 11.00 am	Classes will begin from the third class period.
	When a transportation shut-down is resolved between 11.00 am and 3.00 pm	Classes will begin from the fifth class period.
	When a transportation shut-down is NOT resolved by 3.00 pm	All classes will be cancelled.
Regular Examination		
Univ.	When a transportation shut-down is resolved before 6.30 am	Examinations will begin as usual from the first period.
	When a transportation shut-down is NOT resolved by 6:30 am	All examinations will be cancelled.
Junior College	When a transportation shut-down is resolved before 2.00 pm	Examinations will begin from the 6th period.
	When a transportation shut-down is NOT resolved by 2.00 pm	All examinations will be cancelled.
JR (between MAIBARA and NISHI-AKASHI)		
Kyoto City Bus (all routes)		
Kyoto City Subway (all lines)		
Keihan Electric Railway (between YODOYABASHI or NAKANOSHIMA and DEMACHIYANAGI)		
Hankyu Electric Railway (between KOBE-SANNOMIYA, OSAKA-UMEDA and KYOTO-KAWARAMACHI)		
Kintetsu Electric Railway (between KYOTO and KASHIWARA-JINGU-MAE)		

(2) Storm warning (*Bofu-Keiho*) & Special Warning (*Tokubetsu-Keiho*)

The above-written rules are to be similarly applied only under circumstances caused by Storm warning (*Bofu-Keiho*) and special warning (*Tokubetsu-Keiho*), should it remain in effect in the south area of Kyoto Prefecture.

(3) The transportation referred to the class cancellation rule includes:

Classes		
	When the warning is lifted by 6.30 am	Classes will begin as usual from the first class period.
	When the warning is lifted between 6.30 am and 11.00 am	Classes will begin from the third class period.
	When the warning is lifted between 11.00 am and 3.00 pm	Classes will begin from the fifth class period.
	When the warning is NOT lifted by 3.00 pm	All classes will be cancelled.
Regular Examination		
Univ.	When the warning is lifted by 6.30 am	Examinations will begin as usual from the first period.
	When the warning is NOT lifted by 6.30 am	All examinations will be cancelled.
Junior College	When the warning is lifted by 2.00 pm	Examinations will begin from the sixth period.
	When the warning is NOT lifted by 2.00 pm	All examinations will be cancelled.

(4) Students who live outside of the above areas and cannot come to school because of transportation shut-downs, storm warnings or special warnings, should inform their teachers of this matter.

(5) If a natural disaster occurs, which is not covered in the above rules, classes may be cancelled without advanced warning.
