# IV. Special Japanese Language Course for International Students Admission Examination – April 2022 Admission

The Special Japanese Language Course for International Students is a one-year course for foreign students who wish to enroll in our university or other Japanese universities, and for international students dispatched to our university by an international exchange partner university, in order to teach the Japanese language to these students, and to deepen their understanding of Japanese affairs.

### Term I

Those who are of a nationality other than Japanese, who have Japanese proficiency of Japanese Language Proficiency Test N5 or higher, and for whom one of the following (1) and (2) apply:

- (1) Those who have completed a 12-year course in school education in a foreign country, or those expected to complete it by March 31, 2022, and are qualified to enter university in the country where the educational institution is located, and will turn 18 years old by March 31, 2022
- (2) Those who are recognized by our university as having the same qualifications or higher as (1) above

### Term II

Those who are of a nationality other than Japanese, who have Japanese proficiency of Japanese Language Proficiency Test N5 or higher, and for whom one of the following (1) or (2) apply, as well as (3) and (4):

## Selection Method

Comprehensive judgment on the document examination that emphasizes Japanese language ability and motivation to learn, based on the application documents. However, if a copy of a results transcript that proves Japanese proficiency cannot be submitted, we will conduct an online interview.
